RV Park Rules

Checkout time is 11:00 am – no exceptions please.
Check-in time is 12:00 noon for RV and Tent sites,
1:00 pm for Cabins.

Unscheduled extensions to your stay will probably require a site change and will be subject to availability.

No refunds can be issued without the proper 24-hour notice (by 11:00 am the day before your new departure date). **No exceptions please.** No refunds on cabins.

No open fires are permitted. (City Ordinance)

Please park only in your assigned site. If you wish to change sites, please contact the office staff and they will try to address your needs.

Be cautious in freezing temperatures. All surfaces could be icy. You are responsible for preventing our faucets from freezing by disconnecting your water hose each night.

No on street parking or parking on the grass or patios. Please use overflow parking for extra vehicles.

Our WIFI service is available throughout the park however, **it is not guaranteed at each site.** The main WIFI antenna is located on our RV Park Office Building.

City ordinances require a sewer hose outlet elbow. (Available for purchase in the RV Park Store.)

For safety reasons, we do not allow clotheslines in our park. Four laundry rooms are available for drying clothes.

You are visiting bear country. Please keep all food and coolers inside. BBQ grills should be stored inside when not in use. Protective mats are available for grill use on our plastic tables.

We suggest that if you are leaving the Park for the day, you roll up your awnings as we can have strong, gusty winds at any time.

Frequently Asked Questions

Why doesn't your WIFI work like my internet connection at home?

Our wireless internet has to support over 240 RV, cabins, and tent sites. We are in a remote mountain location and we have a challenge getting adequate broadband service in our area.

Why should you keep your pet(s) on a leash and pick up after them?

We are pleased to be a pet friendly park and want to have our guests enjoy their stay. Being considerate of others by following our pet rules ensures that everyone will have a positive experience.

Why can't we have a campfire?

West Yellowstone has a city ordinance prohibiting campfires.

Why do we ask ATVs and motorcycles to only ride in and out of our park and not ride up and down the rows?

We want everyone to have pleasant stay and some guests complain about noise and extra congestion.

PET RULES

- Quiet, well behaved pets only
- No pets in RV Park Buildings
- Keep pets on a leash at all times
- Use marked pet walk areas
- Pick up after your pets in all locations
- Never leave barking dogs unattended

For the safety of younger guests, we ask that parents accompany children under 12 using the facilities. Children should use extreme caution when crossing or playing near any internal RV Park roads.

For the convenience of all our campers, we have established quiet hours from 10:00 pm to 7:00 am. No running of generators at any time. Please respect your neighbors and don't walk across their site.

RV Park hours, along with emergency phone numbers, are posted at the RV Park Office Building. Restrooms and showers will be closed for cleaning daily.

To maintain our landscaping, the sprinklers come on between midnight and 6:00 am for 30 minutes on each site. Please set your personal property inside to keep it dry.

No tents on RV sites.

Due to maintenance and other extenuating circumstances we cannot guarantee any specific site.

Finally, our most important rule is: enjoy your stay in West Yellowstone and do come back and stay with us again soon!
